- b. **AX8** - 90 hours as Pilot In Command of any Hot Air Balloon
- c. **AX9** - 125 hours as Pilot In Command of any Hot Air Balloon, of which at least 25 hours must be as Pilot In Command of an AX9 or larger Balloon
- d. **160,000 to 180,000 cubic foot FAI size category AX10** - 150 hours as Pilot In Command of any Hot Air Balloon, of which at least 35 hours must be as Pilot In Command of a 160,000 cubic foot or larger Balloon
- e. **210,000 cubic foot or larger FAI size category AX10** - 175 hours as Pilot In Command of any Hot Air Balloon, of which at least 50 hours must be as Pilot In Command of a 210,000 cubic foot or larger Balloon
- f. **210,000 cubic foot or larger Balloon when the Balloon used is an FAI size category AX11 or larger** - 200 hours as Pilot In Command of any Hot Air Balloon, of which at least 50 hours must as Pilot In Command of a 210,000 cubic foot or larger Balloon.
